DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For daily cleaning of sinks and drainboards, dilute 1 ounce of **Richco® STAINLESS STEEL CLEANER** in 1 quart of warm water. Sponge all surfaces and allow to work for several minutes. Wipe clean and rinse thoroughly with water. For heavy scale on equipment, spray or wipe on full strength.

To clean liquor pourers, make a solution of 1 ounce of **Richco® STAINLESS STEEL CLEANER** in 1 quart of warm water. Soak pourers in the solution and rinse thoroughly.

To clean tanks, pipes and trays in ice machines, use 3 to 4 ounces per gallon of water. Turn off water supply and flush solution through ice maker. Rinse thoroughly.
